After renowned missionary Johnathan Goforth (1859-1936) had spoken in a chapel in southern China, a man asked him. He said "I have heard you speak three times, and you always have the same theme, **Jesus Christ**. Why?"

The missionary replied, "Sir, before answering your question, let me ask, 'What did you have for dinner today?'"

"Rice," replied the man. "What did you have yesterday?"

"The same thing." "And what do you expect to eat tomorrow?"

"Rice, and it gives me strength and it is my very life!" The missionary responded quickly,

"What you have said of rice, Jesus is to our soul! He is the 'rice' or 'bread of life, He is passion of my life.'"

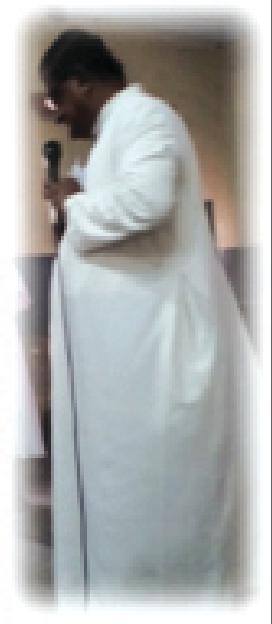
Let the message of Resurrection stir the SCCs with passion and compassion risking our lives ministering through good deeds in society, to meeting people's needs and correcting injustice.
